

# Rosy Glow / Pink Lady®

---



- Rosy Glow – a mutation of Cripps Pink selected by Harleigh Mason in Forest Range, South Australia
- Shows significantly improved Pink Lady® pack-outs over Cripps Pink
- Retains the positive attributes of Cripps Pink that has made it the success which it is
- The amount and the intensity of the over-colour distinguishes it from Cripps' Pink.
- Harvest maturity and storage regime need to be determined accurately to prevent various forms of internal browning.

## Tree

<b>Chilling</b>	Medium
<b>Vigour</b>	Medium
<b>Growth habit</b>	Upright (less basally dominant than Cripps' Pink )
<b>Full bloom</b>	Early to middle October
<b>Pollinators</b>	Granny Smith, Golden Delicious, Royal Gala, Hillieri
<b>Bearing habit</b>	Spurs and tips
<b>Production</b>	Good

<b>Harvest</b>	Middle to late April
<b>Mass/Fruit size</b>	155g
<b>Shape</b>	Oblong
<b>Skin colour</b>	Pink to light red solid blush over a lime yellow background
<b>Lenticels</b>	Inconspicuous
<b>Flesh colour</b>	Creamy white
<b>Taste</b>	Sweet - tart
<b>Texture</b>	Crisp and fine
<b>Storage ability</b>	Very good
