Vigour	Average
Growth habit	Upright and somewhat basally dominant
Full bloom	Early to middle October
Pollinators	Granny Smith, Hillieri
Bearing habit	Tips and laterals
Production	Medium to high with high levels of flowering

Harvest	Second half of February
Mass/Fruit size	125g
Shape	Globose-conical
Skin colour	Yellow/lime green background with red flecked stripe over blush
Lenticels	Inconspicuous
Flesh colour	Creamy
Taste	Sweet and tangy with excellent flavour
Texture	Very crunchy, juicy and firm
Storage ability	Excellent, holds firmness and eats well late season

Needs careful management to ensure not too many fruit set and to ensure formation of many mature spurs. Good light management is critical both for colour and return bloom. A complete bitterpit programme is required. This is a multiple pick variety.
