Blueberry type: Rabbit Eye

Released: 2011

Key attributes: Centra Blue is a very late cropping, medium chill variety

with very good production, decent size and good eating quality. Chosen for its outstanding production with attractive bloom on the fruit, little grittiness, and an exceptionally late fruiting season. It can also be planted

in very cold regions with high altitudes.

Chilling Required: Medium (400-600h < 7.2C).

Flowering: Late Spring (October) PDF = 110 Days.

Pollinator: Sky/Velutto Blue.

Harvest: Very late; start ripening first week of February until end

of March. Has an extended fruiting season, depending

on the climate.

Plant Vigour: Crown-like Rabbit eye type bush, very vigorous &

precocious. Slow growth in the first year of plantings

have been observed.

Yield: Highly productive, averaging approximately 8kg/plant on

mature plants. Observed range 6-10kg/plant (20-30 ton/ha in full production from). Plants mature from the

5th year.





Ripening: Very late ripening. Peak harvest is from Feb - March

Berry size: Medium to large, average 16-18mm size and

averaging 2.2g.

Fruit shape: Oblong to round

Colour/Bloom: Light blue; average bloom.

Picking Scar: Small/Medium dry scar.

Firmness: Average firmness with good shelf life. Recommended

for local marketing.

Flavour: Good eating with average brix (observed range is 9.6–

13.5 brix). The fruit acidity is measured as titratable

acidity averaging 3.8mg/g.

Disease: The plant does not seem to be susceptible to rust.
