





Blueberry type:	Southern Highbush
Released:	2011
Key attributes:	Good eating quality, early to mid-season fruit with high production
Chilling Required:	Medium (-400h < 7.2C)
Flowering:	Flower bud break around mid-August. PDF = 90 Days
Pollinator:	SH variety with similar flowering time
Bud break:	First visible leafs starting end of August.
Harvest:	Mid-season production: from early-November to late December
Plant Vigour:	Semi-Upright to spreading with good vigour
Yield:	Good (15-20 ton/ha)
Berry size:	Small (1.5g), ranging between 12 to 16mm
Fruit shape:	Round
Colour:	Medium blue to light blue
Bloom:	Strong; light blue
Picking Scar:	Small dry scar

Firmness:	Firm with good shelf life
Flavour:	Sweet with high brix, average acidity, very good eating
Disease:	Little rust has been observed. A little anthracnose on fruit has been recorded though no symptoms of Botryosphaeria spp. have been found.
