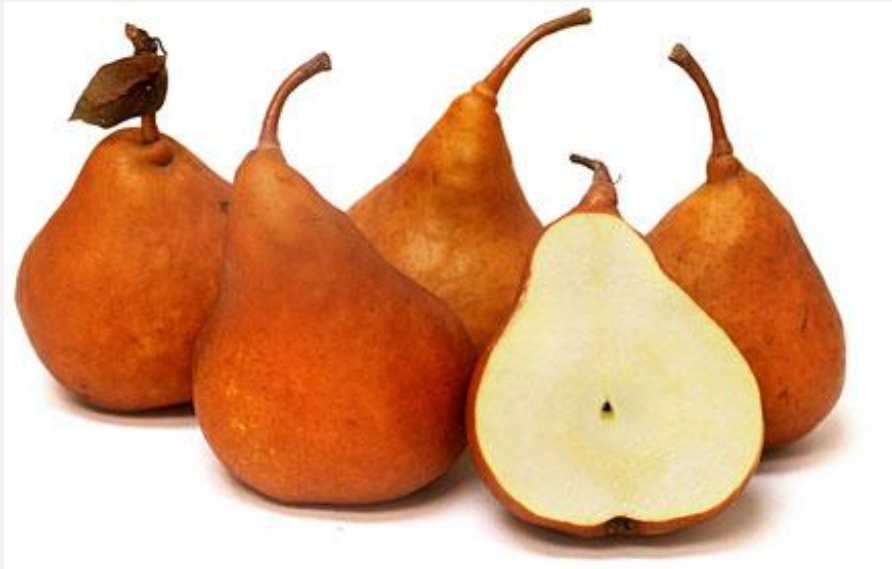

| <b>Pollinators</b>   | Bon Chretien, Beurre Hardy, Packhams’<br>Triumph, Duyenne du Comice |
| <b>Bearing habit</b> | Spurs and shoots  |
| <b>Production</b>    | Medium  |

| <b>Mass/Fruit size</b> | 175g                   |
| <b>Shape</b>           | Oblong-pyriform        |
| <b>Skin colour</b>     | Smooth brown russet    |
| <b>Lenticels</b>       | Inconspicuous          |
| <b>Flesh colour</b>    | Cream                  |
| <b>Taste</b>           | Sweet and juicy        |
| <b>Texture</b>         | Crisp, slightly coarse |
| <b>Storage ability</b> | Good                   |
