

# Miss Lilly™ (TH-948)



- Blueberry type:** Southern Highbush
- Key attributes:** Miss Lilly™ 'TH-948' has large, firm, flavorful berries, concentrated ripening and a very upright growth habit. Candidate for machine harvest. Late flowering with a short ripening period.
- Chilling Required:** Low chill (-400h < 7.2C)
- Flowering:** Flower bud break May-June.  
PDF = 80 Days Flowers two weeks after Star.
- Pollinator:** SH variety with similar flowering time.
- Harvest:** Early to mid-season production: from September to October and has a compact harvesting season. Ripens with Star.
- Plant Vigour:** Upright with good vigorous growth – plant more dense.
- Yield:** Good (15 - 18 ton/ha) plant more plants/ha to compensate.
- Berry size:** Very large size fruit (2–2.3g/berry), ranging between 14-25mm.
- Fruit shape:** Round
- Colour:** Medium blue to light blue

# Miss Lilly™ (TH-948)

<b>Bloom:</b>	Strong; light blue
<b>Picking Scar:</b>	Small dry scar
<b>Firmness:</b>	Firm with good shelf life, similar to Star.
<b>Flavour:</b>	Crisp with good brix & flavour, average acidity. Ave brix 12.5.
<b>Disease:</b>	Little rust has been observed. A little anthracnose on fruit has been recorded. No Botryosphaeria spp. have been found.
<b>Licensed Countries:</b>	Zimbabwe, Zambia, Namibia, Botswana, Swaziland, Lesotho, Mozambique, Angola, Tanzania, Kenya, Malawi, South Africa, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi.
